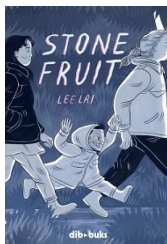

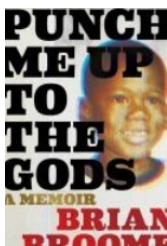

A memoir in essays about sexuality, blackness, masculinity, and addiction.



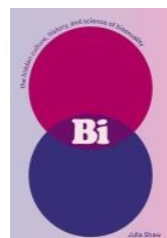

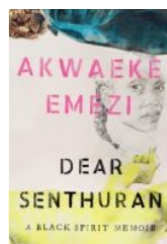
### In the Dream House

While working for a rich family, Lena discovers they are responsible for the ruin of her own family. She embarks on a quest for revenge where she must decide how much she is willing to risk for payback.



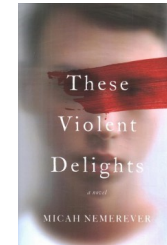
### Margaret and the Mystery of the Missing Body

In 1970s Pittsburg, a painfully insecure artist falls in love with a charming, student before their relationship spirals into an all-consuming obsession.



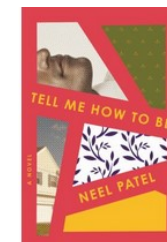
### Vagabonds!

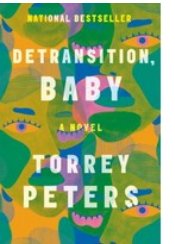

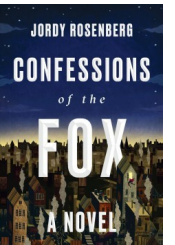
### Detransition, Baby

A love story set in the eighteenth-century London of notorious thieves and queer subcultures, this genre-bending debut tells a profound story of gender, desire, and liberation.



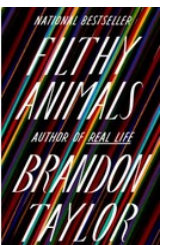
### Young Mungo
